| 5 | CEO Update | | | |
| | JB presented her thoughts and strategic observations since the last meeting. An examination of the role that active partnerships are expected to play: An emphasis on place based, community powered change, being nationally enabled and locally led. CJ likened this to a 'virtuous Circle', discussion on refining visual schematics for strategy representation. Suggestions included highlighting continuous feedback loops and system-wide connections. JB was in agreement that this is a helpful concept. JB provided an update on MSP's work to expand place partnerships: Four places in the region part of the bid, with universal offer to expand to additional locations | | | |



- Place-based work supported by a £250M Sport England initiative; additional universal offer award anticipated early next year to help support further, particularly in those areas not targeted in the main bid.
- Collaboration with Greater Manchester for learning support.

JB delivered a breakdown of projected investment and significant resources incoming to support in 2025.

Embedding the team within communities and places

- There was a request for the inclusion of Southport for area of recovery, learning from the community throughout the process of recovery.
- Embedding inception meetings within local communities with an array of different organisations attending

JB delivered an update on the team, two Sport Welfare Officers recruited (after a second round to get the right people) and also recruited a Finance, Compliance and Operations Officer and all three settling in well. The Place Partnership funding will see two additional posts. Working on growth and development within the team including the work undertaken with Nicky Hawkins around messaging.

MC asked if change of government is projected to affect the funding of Sport England and MSP. JB responded that there is ministerial buy-in until 2031.

6 LT Updates

Health DW

Delivered an update focused on Liverpool and Wirral Place Partnership work:

 Liverpool: Starting further ahead of other Places having worked with Sport England on Navigating Local Systems. Inception Meetings took place in October and December, with over 150+ stakeholders present and some really positive shifts in language used and distributed leadership



- Wirral: Work is focused on three Medium Super Output Areas, and were the first to host an Inception Meeting in September. New group formed to help guide the direction of the work, with some good examples of collaboration forming and some strong assets to build upon
- Health work: Better alignment for All Together Active and evaluation & learning with MSP role and Place Partnership work, with refreshed strategy coming for 2026. Better relationships with the ICB, and a positive stakeholder event hosted in St Helens with 130+ people in attendance. Big opportunity around the 'pivot to wellbeing' agenda, and looking at longer term commissioning arrangements which would be a positive shift

CYP CD

Delivered an update on CYP and NGBs/Sport

- Physical literacy being the focus for the team; who ran a network session for the region to get buy-in on physical literacy.
- Creating Active Schools framework, critical focus on Knowsley with policy change to become an Active School.
- identified that the biggest challenge currently is to get schools to commit time and resources during the current climate.

CD delivered update on how we connect with partners and NGBs and how connections are forming between NGBs and some are moving forward with working in a place based way.

MC asked questions regarding the current pressure in the voluntary sector and how this affects our work at MSP.

CD response that we have not yet delved deep enough within place based working to fully understand the extent of reliance on volunteers. There was an acknowledgement of the current difficulty in recruiting volunteers and that current volunteers are frequently asked to donate more time.

DW Shared LCR volunteering portal needs to be utilised at a local level. Social prescribing relies heavily on the voluntary sector and government policy change is needed to shift resource where it is needed.
